In order to be successful in your study of foreign language this year, you must have:

You are also expected to:

- 1. attend class every day and participate in a positive way
- 2. adhere to all school and district policies regarding expected behaviors
- 3. store your personal electronic devices as indicated by the classroom teacher before entering the classroom
- 4. complete all homework assignments and projects in a timely manner
- 5. study for all assessments
- 6. make up ALL of work you miss due to absence
- 7. communicate with your teacher in the event that you do not understand the material
- 8. attend extra help when you need assistance with the course material
- 9. participate in all learning activities to develop your language proficiency
- 10. refrain from using any electronic translators (i.e. Google Translate)
- 11. follow all the class policies listed below

1. HOMEWORK:

Homework assignments will be given four times a week as outlined in the district's homework policy bulletin. These assignments must be completed whether you are present or absent from class. If you are absent from class, you will be given time, as determined by your teacher, to make up for the work you missed. Homework that is handed in late will lose credit.

2. CLASS PARTICIPATION:

You are expected to participate in the language of instruction of your class. In keeping with the New York State and District Curriculum Guides, you will be graded on the quality of your speaking performance in the target language on assessments including, but not limited to: quizzes, unit tests, presentations and projects as well as on the final examination. Being prepared for class with pen, notebook, iPad and homework is part of class participation. Your class participation will be assessed each marking period.

3. QUIZZES:

Generally, there are weekly quizzes, depending on the topic. The quizzes will reflect the current material studied in class. The quizzes can be written, listening and/or oral. Quizzes will be given according to the school testing schedule.

4. TESTS and PROJECTS:

Assessments will be projects or exams of listening, writing, reading, or speaking skills. Tests will be announced at least five days in advance according to the school's testing schedule. They will be given at the end of each topical unit. In addition to tests, there will also be some type of project assigned during each marking period. Projects will count as test grades.

5. SCHOOL ISSUED ELECTRONIC DEVICES (iPad)

Students are expected to keep their school-issued iPads charged and in good condition. In general, personal electronic devices will not be used for instruction in World Languages classrooms.

6. REPORT CARD GRADE
